The trust works to improve the lives of disadvantaged young people through career guidance, work experience, and community support networks.
- 4. Penny Lane Centers (LA) The mission of this non-profit organisation is to foster hopes and dreams by empowering children, young adults, homeless people, and families to reach their highest potential. The clients range from newborn to 24 years old.
- DINE11 (US) Help feed healthcare workers on the front lines with this great organisation. They have teamed up with some of the best chefs and beloved restaurants to provide delicious, nourishing, free meals to doctors, nurses, and crucial hospital stuff.
- 6. <u>Refuge</u> (UK) Provides emergency accommodation and support to women and children escaping domestic violence and other forms of violence and abuse.
- 7. <u>Futures Without Violence</u> (US) is a health and social justice non-profit organisation with a simple mission: to heal those who are traumatised by violence, including domestic violence, child abuse, bullying, and sexual assault



- 1. <u>Questlove live streams</u> No other person has done more for (and with) music during quarantine than Rootsdrummer and DJ, Questlove. His journeys into music history are simply stellar, wildly entertaining, and will keep you listening for days on end.
- 2. The Scumfrog MBTS 7 MBTS stands for Most Below The Surface. In the pre-Covid days this used to be the name of my club nights in New York City, London, and Barcelona. Like many of my peers, I have done the occasional live stream since isolation started, and this was the stream I recorded in late March in the Bahamas.
- 3. <u>Kit Sebastian</u> A French/Turkish duo that just released an amazing new album. Possibly even more amazing is the playlist they created for Spotify. If you're on a long road trip this might just be your best musical backdrop of trippy old tunes.
- 4. The Scumfrog Friends With Boats Vol. 4 Back in 2007 I went on a sailing trip in the BVIs with a group of friends. This trip inspired me to create a mix-CD (those were the days) titled 'Friends With Boats'. The CD was a big hit, and not just with boat owners, so I kept making new chapters whenever I felt inspired. My personal favourite from the series is Volume 4 from 2018. Check it out, and if you like it then you'll be able to google Volume 5 as well!
- 5. <u>Dead Tones Podcast 17</u>
 West African/Parisian/Californian producer Kamel Omais
 AKA Dead Tones is a fellow lover of rare 70s-inspired
 Electronic Music. This recent DJ mix is a 4-plus-hour
 journey of bliss!

- 6. <u>DJ Subcora Archetype</u> Turkish born Pinar Öztop aka DJ Subcora has quickly become one of my favourite music selectors. She lives in the UK and has a vast allround knowledge of cool music. This particular mix is very chill, but if you like what you hear, jump onto her page and start exploring her other stuff too!
- 7. Tame Impala Slow Rush The ideal artist and album to provide the entry-level into a world of less obvious music. Still polished pop, but with a strong psychedelic edge. This new album, by one of my favourite contemporary mainstream artists, is the perfect transition if your afternoon is stuck on Spotify algorithms giving you the same 80s hits over and over and over.
- 8. <u>Craig Mullin Barge Party</u> A veteran DJ from Canada's West Coast. This mix spans multiple genres, with its first hour being full of groovy hits and almost-hits. After the first hour Craig will take you on a tour of the more obscure stuff, with an emphasis on solid disco grooves.
- 9. <u>Sébastien Léger The Man With The Red Face</u> This video is great if you love electronic music and you're wondering what all those DJs have been up to when they are not playing in large clubs and festivals.
